kid's corner

Especially for the younger members in Worship Service.

- 1) Do you ever think about why we read passages from the Bible during the service, not just when the pastor is preaching?
- 2) Why do you think collecting money during the service is actually a part of Worship?
- 3) Why is it good to honor people who work hard to do ministry, like we are doing today for the Mr. Chris and Mrs. Carla Raasch who have been leading our Live Wires ministry?
- 4) What did you learn about God and “holiness” in the Bible message today?

Questions for further growth: Below are questions for families, friends, and individuals to use for follow up from the message to cause interactive discussion. Depending on the ages of those participating, and how much time they have, these can be answered over different days or squeezed together in short conversations.

- 1) Compare the angels of Isaiah 6:2, Ezekiel 1, Revelation 4:6-10, Matthew 18:10, Hebrews 1:5-14, and Daniel 10:10-21. What do we learn about angels from these passages?
- 2) Read the first 5 chapters of Isaiah, and 2 Chronicles chapter 26. Isaiah prophesied primarily to the Southern Kingdom of Judah during the reign of 4 Kings (Isaiah 1:1). The Northern Kingdom of Israel fell to their Assyrian captors in 721 BC, and Judah was besieged by Assyria in 701 BC. Later to come, Judah would be conquered by Babylonian armies beginning in 603 BC. In the context of the Scripture readings, how does all this magnify the short introductory line in Isaiah 6:1 and the vision that follows?
- 3) Consider the topic of God's holiness. (Isaiah 6, Revelation. 4, 1 Peter 1:15). Evaluate the difference between God saying “Be holy, for I am holy”, and God not saying “Be as holy as I am holy”.

PROMISSORY NOTE UPDATE

Praise God that the response for participation in the Promissory Note Program was more than sufficient to proceed to the next step of the program: having an attorney draw up a promissory note contract that will be used to formalize the agreement between the participant and CVC. However, there is still room for some more participation to be able to roll over the complete mortgage with the bank to promissory notes. If you are interested in helping roll over the complete mortgage call the for more information or contact them by phone. The benefit would be two-fold: For CVC, lower costs to finance the land on North Avenue (which will save up to \$8000 in mortgage interest per year), and for you as a participant, a much higher investment income than available in money market accounts. IRA funds and 401(k) funds are eligible for this investment.
